Bronx River Pathway The Pathway consists of three paved segments: a one-mile loop near Oak Street in Mount Vernon; a 3.6-mile section from Palmer Road in Bronxville north to Harney Road in Scarsdale and a 5-mile section extending from Green Acres Avenue in Hartsdale to Kensico Dam Plaza in Valhalla.

Old Croton Trailway State Historic Park. The Old Croton Aqueduct Trailway Westchester County section begins at the New York City/Yonkers line and threads its way north for 26.2 miles to Croton Gorge Park. The trailway is divided into three sections of about 9, 11, and 12 miles. The Aqueduct today hosts one of the most intriguing walks in the state. For information, call 914-693-0529, www.aqueduct.org

Untermeyer Park North Broadway (just south of St. John's Hospital) The Park is open year round from dawn to dusk. Free admission. (914) 377-6450 www.untermyer.org

Sprain Ridge Park Jackson Avenue. This 270-acre park in the county's southern end there are many ponds and ravines here and three hiking trails with views overlooking the Sprain Ridge reservoir. A county park pass is required for admission. (914) 478-2300.
